This may be done by: 1) taking an additional course (200 or 300 level) in the language used to meet the requirement. Either a language course or a course taught in the foreign language on a specific topic may satisfy the extra language requirement; or 2) taking a two-semester sequence of courses in a new foreign language (101 and 102), which can be taken at Princeton or in an approved, intensive *summer language program that meets for at least eight weeks* and covers at least two semesters of material. Students who are bilingual may have this requirement waived.
